“The 2007 Jester Shiraz is dark ruby/purple-colored with an alluring perfume of mineral, earth notes, blueberry, black cherry, and blackberry. “Bright ruby. Dark berry and cherry compote on the nose, with black pepper and clove adding nuance. One to Savour

“Mitolo is a small family owned winemaker from McLaren Vale in South Australia. The winery was set up in 1999 by Frank Mitolo with renowned winemaker Ben Glaetzer as a partner. The 2007 Jester, named in honour of the jester Tarlton from the court of Elizabeth I, is a cracker of a wine. Rich, voluptuous and velvety, this shiraz shows ripe dark berry and plum flavours with added vanillin, coconut, liquorice and violets. It has an underlying spiciness including cinnamon and white pepper, and beautifully balanced oak and attractive tannins. There is plenty of flavour for the price.”

“This wine shows more fragrant blue and blackberry characteristics than the 2006, resulting from smaller berries providing more concentrated fruit. Frank Mitolo says he is very selective in the oak used for the maturation of all Mitolo Wines. All five vintages of Jester Shiraz have been matured in French oak which was previously used for ageing Mitolo G.A.M. Shiraz.”
