### **Robert Parker – The Advocate 2003**

94-96 points

The Reiver 2002 is aged in 100% French oak of which 70% is new. Sweet floral, black and blue fruit aromas soar from the glass of this black/purple coloured 2002. Extremely full-bodied, deep and chewy with tremendous purity as well as texture, it is another remarkably well-balanced bohemian from South Australia that should age effortlessly for 15+ years.

### **Jeremy Oliver**

17.8 points

Deeply perfumed shiraz, scented with floral aromas, fresh jujube-like nuances of cassis and redcurrants, cedary oak and musky spices. Medium to full in weight, it's a plush, smooth wine of style and polish. Stained with dark fruits, with a spicy complexity suggestive of licorice and black pepper, it's fine and supple, and could even handle a little more substance, and structure. Drink 2007-2010

### **James Halliday - The Weekend Australian, 5th/6th June 2004**

95 points

Mitolo Wines Reiver Barossa Shiraz, a focussed, supple and smooth array of black and red fruits; ripe tannins; great balance and length; quality oak, beautifully made. Drink 2022
