### 93 POINTS

As an homage to the estate's Italian heritage, a percentage of the fruit was dried in the appassimento style, enforcing a carapace of strapping tannins melded with darker, thicker fruit tones. The result is full-bodied and highly appetising, the coffee bean tannins curtailing the wine's density and providing poise. This said, cabernet's DNA is strong beneath the fray: currant, sap, sage and hedgerow. Very well done. Finely balanced and eminently drinkable.
