Deep colour; very true to its terroir, but with a commendable juicy edge to its black fruit and dark chocolate core which adds suppleness to the black-palate and finish.

Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2008 Jester 'Tarlton' Shiraz reveals an abundance of black cherry, blackberry, cinnamon and licorice notes with hints of vanilla and mocha. Crisp, full bodied and rich in the mouth, it has a medium level of rounded tannins and a long finish. Approachable now, it should drink well to 2015+.
