A very tart and tangy, red-fruited style with a crunchy, fresh palate that has an elegant, slightly tangy, citrusy finish. Drink now. Screw cap.

Juicy and slightly savoury shiraz from McLaren Vale. Lots of soft blackberry fruit mingling with plums and a slightly tart black olive nuance. The finish is poised and very long. Excellent wine for the medium term.

Opens with a generous nose of plum and kisses of savoury olive and McLaren Vale graphite pencil lead with mushy tart blackberry and a 'Redskin' lolly childhood reminiscence. Spicy, sharp and tangy, with herbaceous anise lilt over grainy, fine tannins. Bold, yet playful and an easy match for so many foods.

Delightfully ripe and inviting, the bouquet shows dark plum, ripe cherry, floral and cocoa characters with a hint of spicy complexity. It is succulent and supple on the palate, offering fleshy mouthfeel and silky tannins, leading to a lengthy flavoursome finish. At its best: now to 2025.
