An interesting variation on the GSM blend, this uses sagrantino instead of mourvedre with grenache and shiraz. The result is a rich, complex blend showing dark berry fruit, plum, licorice, spice and a savoury note from the sagrantino, all matured in older French oak barrels. Enjoy over the next five years or more with rich lamb or beef based casseroles.
