### ***Robert Parker - The Advocate 2004***

96-100 points

The spectacular, dense, ruby/purple coloured 2003 Shiraz G.A.M. (named after the Mitolo family's three children) exhibits aromas of lead pencil shavings, blackberries, blueberries, cassia, licorice, new oak, and scorched earth.

This complex 2003 comes across as a hypothetical blend of a great La Mission Haut Brion from Bordeaux and a Rhone Valley Hermitage such as Chapoutier's Pavillon. Everything is seamlessly integrated into this tour de force in winemaking. It should age for 10-16+ years.

### ***Campbell Mattinson - Gourmet Traveller Wine, June/July 2005***

With its name made up of the initials of the Mitolo children – Gemma, Alex and Marco – this offers intense and sweet liquid aniseed followed by a swell of leather and a throw of dried garden herbs. Unusual wine. Not just a blockbuster, it's also complex and interesting.

### ***James Halliday Wine Companion 2006***

5\* rating, 94 points

Herb and spice edges to the aroma; full-bodied, powerful and dense blackberry and bitter chocolate palate fruit; controlled but ample tannins. 14.5° alcohol.
