The 2007 Serpico Cabernet Sauvignon offers up toast, chocolate covered cherries, and mineral notes. Structured and a bit compact, it will round out with a few more years of bottle age but without the generosity normally associated with this cuvee.

Dense garnet hue. Complex flavors of black cherry, wintergreen and menthol with a whiff of oak. Vibrant acidity and juicy flavors of raspberry and cassis. Hints of leather and sweet tobacco in the lingering close.

By some distance the best release yet under this label, with dusty, herbal aromas of dark olives and dark violets, cassis and meaty undertones. Framed by tight, drying tannins, it's long and meaty, firm and fine-grained, with a bony extract and a lingering savoury finish. It needs rich Italian food!
