Rich and ripe, dense with jammy black currant and blackberry flavors that push against a refined grip of tannins, finishing plush and expressive. Best after 2015.

A powerhouse of dark berries and regional purity united with mocha / cedary oak. Cassis, plums and violets are evident from front-to-back, with ample mouth feel and fleshy tannins, this is another enjoyable vintage of Serpico.

Deep garnet in color, the 2010 Serpico Cabernet Sauvignon is scented of creme de cassis, dried Provence herbs and menthol with hints of chocolate box, dried lavender and pencil shavings. Full-bodied with tons of cassis flavor in the mouth, it has a medium level of slightly astringent tannins and just enough acidity to enliven through the long finish with lingering herbal notes. Drink it now to 2019.
