Pristine and fragrant, the inviting bouquet shows Black Doris plum, cranberry, thyme, almond and floral aromas, followed by a wonderfully weighted palate that is succulent and beautifully flowing. It is youthfully charming and delightfully drinkable, elegantly framed by supple tannins. At its best: now to 2026.

Black cherry and blackberry fruit with McLaren Vale dark raspberry with undertones of jager herbs, licorice and light tar. Limited oak influence (older oak used). Chewy, grainy tannin wraps the bright black/purple fruit with a deliciously long, textural tail. Medium to full bodied and a wonderful partner for tomato sugo based pastas.
