2019 OF THE WIND CHARDONNAY  
ADELAIDE HILLS



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### 94 POINTS

Hewn of fruit from a prized single site in the cooler sub-zone of Macclesfield, this ascribes to the code of much contemporary Australian chardonnay: hand harvest, whole-bunch pressed and barrel fermented across small batches prior to blending. The result is delicious, with effortless poise between fruit weight and acidity than other wines in the range. Nicely restrained and far from fruity. It billows rather than sears. Gently, with stone fruit accents, notes of oatmeal, toasted nuts and nougat. The oak, nicely nestled. The finish long and expansive. A delicious wine.
